re: Your Requests of April 21 and 27 for Education Fund Documents

Dear President Stern:

As I indicated in my April 28 letter responding to your above requests for additional Education Fund documents, I was unable to obtain everything you requested within the 24-hour deadline you specified; however, I promised to furnish additional documents as soon as I could obtain them.

In accordance therewith, please find enclosed a copy of the IRS Form 1023 filed by the United Healthcare Workers and Patients Education Fund in support of its application for a 501(c)(3) exemption. In addition, I am enclosing copies of various Fund directors' meeting agendas. I have only now obtained these documents from the Fund and reject any implication that your request for these documents has been resisted.

As per your request for the Fund's estimation of outstanding expenses, it is our understanding that these are incidental expenses associated with the termination of telephone services, which has been done. I will supply you with the details when I receive them. In addition, we have been informed that consultant Arthur Fox is returning to the Fund \$53,312.50 as the unearned portion of the retainer of \$75,000 which he received. Thus, combined with the monies retained by the Fund about which you have been previously informed, we expect that an additional sum around \$120,000 will be returned by the Fund to the UHW-W, provided that the Fund does not incur any unanticipated expenses in winding down its affairs.
