

**NOTICE OF CONTINUATION
OF HEARING ON WHETHER
A TRUSTEE SHOULD BE APPOINTED
AT SEIU UNITED HEALTHCARE WORKERS–WEST
UNDER ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 7 OF THE SEIU CONSTITUTION
(CORRECTED)**


**To: All Officers and Members of SEIU United Healthcare Workers–West,
Service Employees International Union, CtW, CLC**

Pursuant to Article VIII, Section 7(a) and (f) of the SEIU Constitution and Bylaws, and the Labor–Management Reporting and Disclosure Act (“LMRDA”), 29 U.S.C. § 462, a hearing was called and convened on September 26–27, 2008 for the purpose of determining whether a Trustee should be appointed to take charge and control of the affairs of SEIU United Healthcare Workers–West (“UHW–W”) and a trusteeship imposed over UHW–W. This hearing will be continued.

The continuation of the hearing will take place on November 12, 13, 14 and 15 (if necessary), 2008 at the Hilton San Jose, 300 Almaden Boulevard, San Jose, California, commencing at 9:00 a.m. on November 12, 2008 and running until recessed by the hearing officer. The hearing will resume at 9:00 a.m. on November 13th and November 14th, and again will run until recessed each day. On November 15th (if necessary), the hearing will resume at 9:00 a.m. and run until concluded. In addition, the hearing will be transmitted by simultaneous video broadcast to the San Jose Convention & Cultural Facilities, Civic Auditorium, 135 West San Carlos Street, San Jose, CA. The hearing officer will be Secretary Ray Marshall.

Consistent with the Statement of Hearing Procedures, members and officers of UHW–W shall have the right to appear at this hearing, to present testimony and other evidence through witnesses and/or documents and to state their position on the imposition of the trusteeship. Upon the conclusion of the hearing, the hearing officer will make a report and recommendation to the International President orally or in writing, on the imposition of trusteeship. The International President shall take his decision to the SEIU International Executive Board which will make the ultimate determination on the trusteeship.
